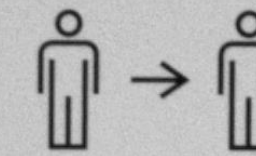
It is important to know the following:

Wearing a mask in the museum is obligatory.



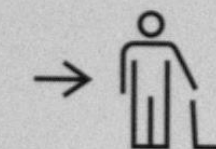

Follow the instructions of the EMST staff for the number of people allowed to enter the museum and for guidance regarding your safety.



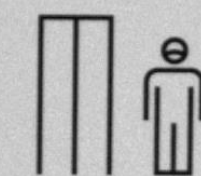
Χρησιμοποιείτε αντισηπτικό χεριών κατά την είσοδο στο μουσείο.

Masks, gloves, water bottles and other objects should be thrown away in the trash bins located outside the building.

The machines make a noise
when a visitor carries metal objects.

For this reason, in the museum
visitors do not carry metal objects,
such as knives or scissors.



In the museum's entrance there is a ticket office.

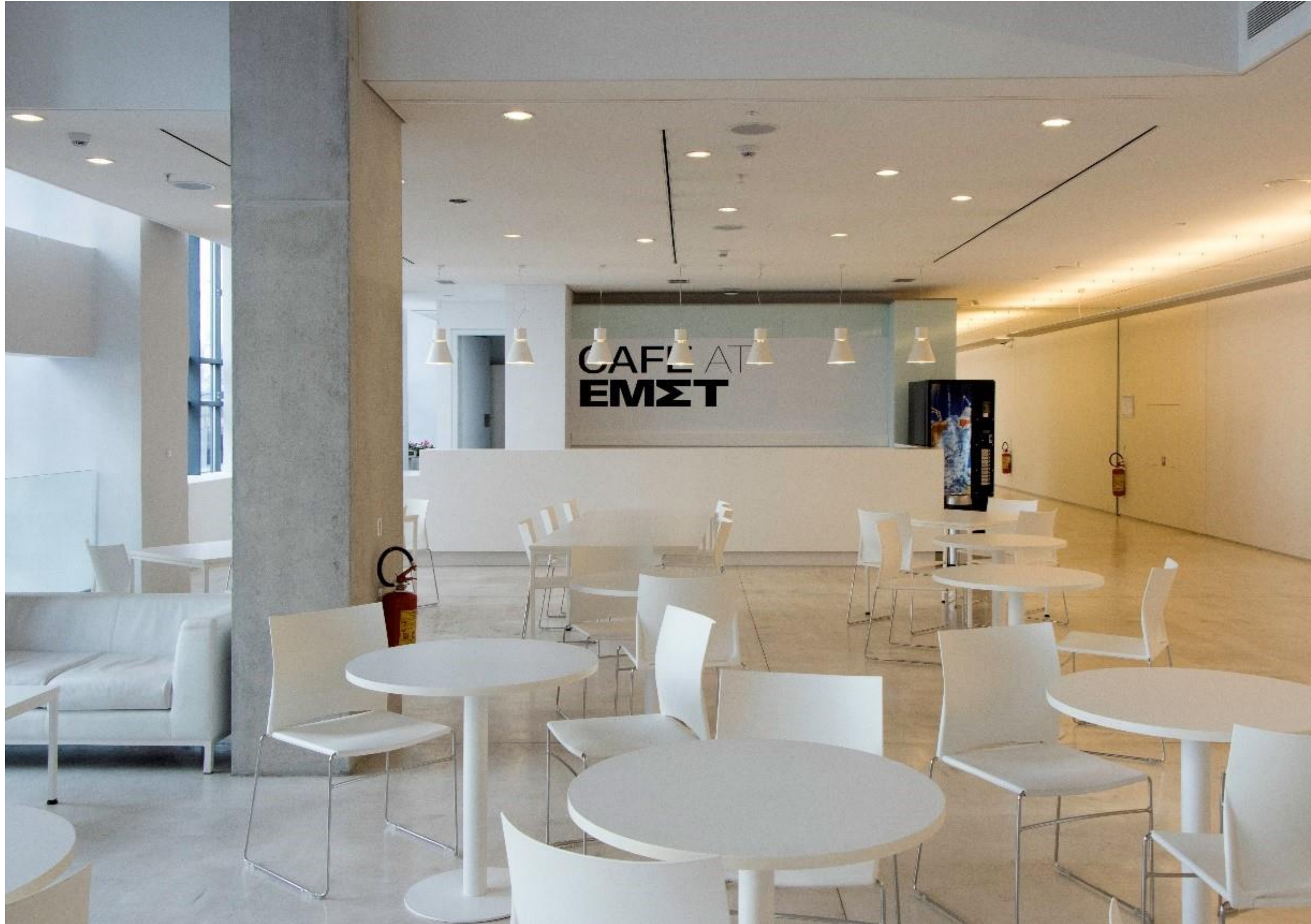
In the ticket office,

and get their ticket.

In the museum's entrance, there is an Information Desk where visitors can ask for more information about the museum and how it operates.

The employees will try to answer visitors' questions.



The Café is on the ground floor.

The Museum Shop
is on the ground floor.



There are escalators
to go up and down
the building.

Visitors can observe the artworks.

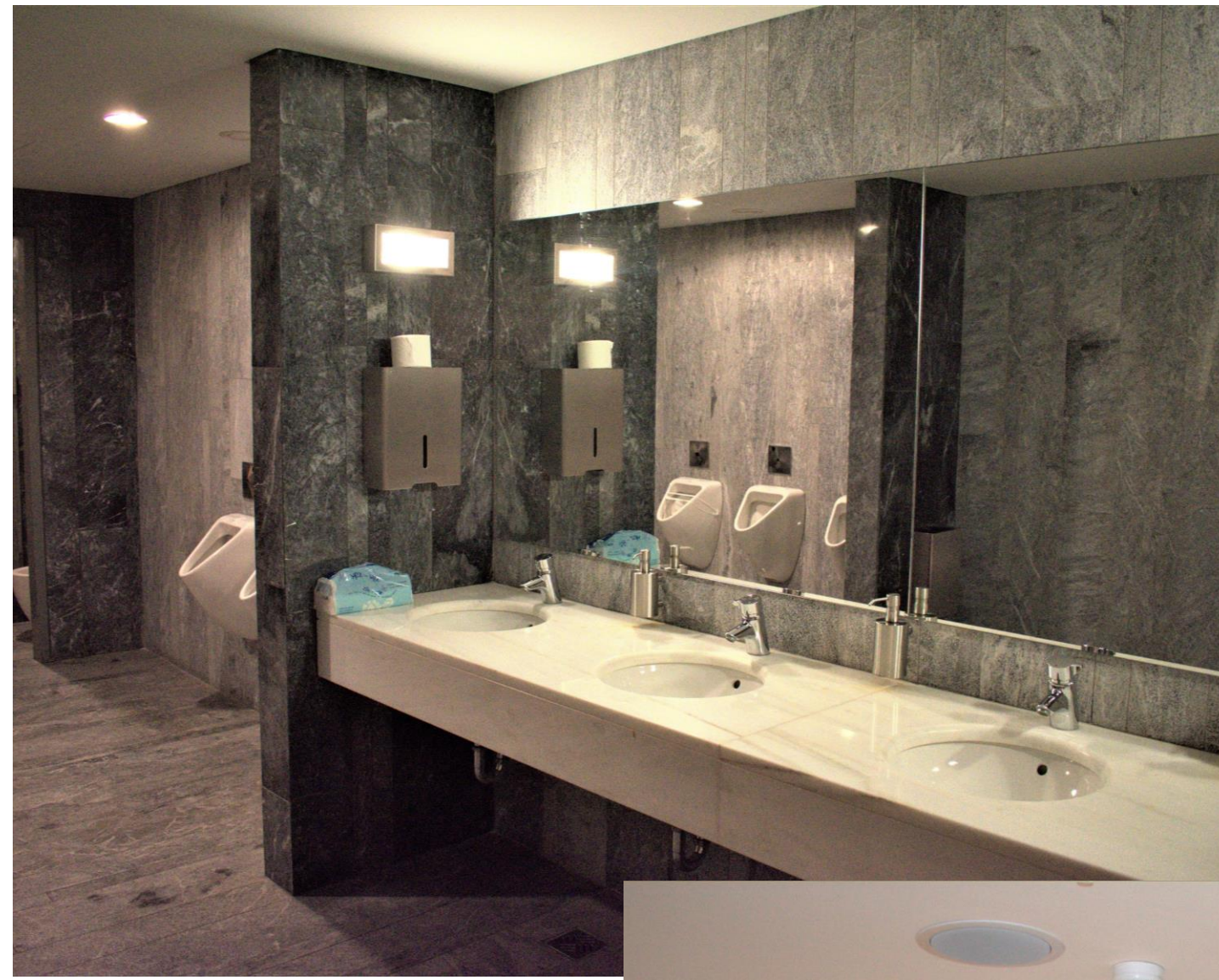
Visitors cannot touch the artworks.
